The Town of Wolseley is located approximately one hundred kilometers (100 KM) East of Regina, Saskatchewan on Highway No. 1. The Canadian Pacific Railway ("CPR") travels through our small rural community, with the rail line adjacent to our downtown commercial district on the North side, and a residential district on the South side.

The Town of Wolseley has experienced train derailments in the past, none of which involved crude oil, although this is very frightening to think about. Each day the very frequent CPR trains travel through Town with various cars. It is our hope crude oil will no longer be transported via rail, but rather pipeline for this reason.

The intention of this letter is to provide support to the Energy East Pipeline project, because as a community, we have seen more than enough rail disasters involving crude oil affect municipalities across this nation.
